Questions from the Public

Does the SSA boundary go up 51st St near the residential area?

 An SSA is intended for commercial areas only, thus SSA #61 purposedly avoided residential uses.



Why is the SSA overlapping with City Services?

• SSA #61 is an extension of Chicago City services, it serves as extra attention to a specific area and is able to allocate additional resources. Chicago must provide and distribute equal attention everywhere and therefore cannot always focus on one location.

Is there something that can be done with viaduct cleaning and pigeons?

Viaduct cleaning will be a two-part process and SSA #61 is budgeting extra to keep up
with clean-up as well as implementing education components (such as letting people
know not to feed pigeons).
